Value-Based Health Care

❑ Value can be defined as;

*“PATIENT HEALTH OUTCOMES per
RUPEE SPENT”*

❑ If we do not measure outcomes,
we cannot determine value



Value-Based Health Care

- Care based on Total Quality System approach**
 - Transparent/Objective/ Patient Centric
 - Leadership-Empowerment
 - Compliances Embedded
- Reimbursement aligned with the VALUE**
 - Pay for performance
 - Patient satisfaction index
 - Bundled payment for entire care cycle



Value-Based Health Care

- Value for patients is not merely lowering of costs
- Value is also not about more treatment; it is all about better health, including:
 - Emphasis on prevention
 - Early detection
 - Making right diagnosis
 - Avoiding complications



Value-Based Health Care

- ❑ Care organized around patient's medical condition over full cycle of care encompassing outpatient, inpatient and rehabilitative care as well as supporting services (i.e. nutrition, social work, behavioral health etc.
- ❑ In most cases, care gets delivered in a sequential & un-coordinated way, with focus on caring for specific set of medical conditions.



Value-Based Health Care

- Care team led by clinician & care manager, oversee each patient care process
- The team, measures outcomes, costs & processes for each patient using common template
- The team meets formally & informally on a regular basis to discuss patient's processes & outcomes



Value-Based Health Care

- When costs & outcomes are to be accurately measured, I.T. is employed to make it dynamic, efficient & effective (SMART HOSPITALS)
- Integration of all types of data i.e. notes, images etc. for each patient
- Aggregate data that encompasses the full care cycle
- Access & communication among all stake holders including patients.





Take away

- Empowerment will be the key
- Focus on
 - Safety (Outcomes)
 - Cost
- Time to be “SMART”
 - Structure (Digital + Green)
 - Process (LEAN)
