



All of these understood the needs of their customer very well


Re-looked at their business models to fulfill their needs

Innovated on products/ services/ delivery model which would fulfill those needs




Few Statistics – certain challenges in existing infrastructure

Severe gap in availability of healthcare infrastructure




Beds per 1,000

80% of Healthcare delivery through the unorganized sector




Existing Infrastructure skewed towards urban areas


E Commerce and Mobile apps disrupting the "Normal" in Healthcare ecosystem
